#### 1. Financial statement disclosure

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with standards applicable to compilation engagements and accordingly do not contain all the disclosures required under Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations.

Some users may require further information as these statements have not been prepared for general purposes.

#### 2. Purpose of the Society

Mission Hospice Society (the "society") was incorporated under the Society Act of British Columbia. The society is a community-based charitable organization providing life-enhancing support to individuals and families living with terminal illness, death and grief. The society is a registered charity under the Income Tax Act.

#### 3. Restricted funds

#### Internally restricted funds

Surplus amounts have been restricted for the building fund and specific programs. During the fiscal year restricted funds earned interest of \$290 (2019 - \$913); The board approved the restriction of a further \$60,000 on January 18, 2021 to fund future operating costs. Restricted funds total \$176,050 (2019 - \$116,050) at the end of the fiscal year.

#### Capital project fund

In November 2020 the society received a \$300,000 bequest. These funds have been restricted by the Board in order to upgrade and expand the premises. This capital project is expected to begin in June 2021 with completion expected by the end of 2021.

#### 4. Deferred revenue

Grants received during the fiscal year related to a future fiscal year are recorded as deferred and recognized as revenue when the specified services are performed.
